## FMWM MISSIONARIES

Currently 34 missionaries representing FMC-USA in Europe.

### These included:

- 8 FMWM extended-term missionaries living in and serving Europe,
- 4 FMWM VISA/associate missionaries living in and serving Europe,
- 8 FMWM Visa/Voyagers missionaries living in and serving Europe,
- 2 FMWM VISA/associate missionaries serving Europe, from the USA,
- 1 FMWM – VISA/associate missionary raising support for deployment,
- 9 International missionaries living in Europe, and (2 from Europe to São Tomé)
- 2 Affiliate missionaries
- 6 missionaries will be coming off the field in 2021; Andersons, Mellingers and Sweets

## FUTURE PLANS

- Exploratory trips to Croatia and Moldova
- Appointment of Zsuzsa McNamara, from Hungary as prayer coordinator.
- Launching of prayer network in April
- Working on videos highlighting our vision of **equipping** leaders, **engaging** with a contextual Gospel message, and **establishing** relevant churches
- Planning on ordaining at least 4 elders and receiving 6 CMCs
- Vision and strategy retreat with Leadership Core Team, date TBD
- Missionary/Partnership encounter cruise planned for October, 2021

## 2020 DEVELOPMENTS

- Establishment of the Balkan Provisional Annual Conference / February 2020
- European Roundtable - Presentation from Europe leaders to supporters on FB Live / May 2020
- Six ordinations, in the Canary Islands (Spain) and Portugal
- Creation of the African European Church Network. Rev. Albert Delali, from the U.K. leads this ministry / September 2020
- Appointment of Debra Gilmore, trained as a facilitator with Support Raising Solutions (SRS)

### Spring 2021

- Appointment of Larry Winckles as Europe Associate Area Director / February 2021
  - Area administrator, developing an admin/budget team
- First SRS course was held in March 2021, with fifteen participants from Europe and Asia
- Balkan Provisional Annual Conference held through Zoom. March 27<sup>th</sup>, 2021
  - Election of Supt. Blagoi Dimitrov
  - 3 new Ordinands and 1 CMC
